

Puget Sound Antique Tractor and Machinery Association Barrel Train Requirements

The intent of these requirements is to provide a safe and fun environment for attendees of the Show.

- 1. Drivers and spotters must be a PSATMA member, be at least sixteen (16) years old and be approved by the Board. The Driver must have a valid driver's license. The Spotter must accompany the barrel ride at all times in a modified comfortable seat at the end of the train.
- 2. The Driver and Spotter must communicate with each other to ensure the safety of the riders. The Spotter will tell the riders when it is safe to enter and exit the train after proper communication is made with the Driver. The Spotter and Driver must communicate prior to departure to ensure that it is safe to go. Driver and Spotter must be provided instructions for proper communications.
- 3. Riders will enter and exit only at the designated location. The train will not stop during its designated route unless there is an emergency. A sign with rules and time of the train loop will be posted at the pick-up/drop-off location.
- 4. Only children who can properly fit the barrel may ride the train. Children must be supervised by their parent or guardian

when entering and exiting. Adults will not ride the train but are encouraged to walk alongside the train if their child needs attention. If the child must get out of the train during the ride they may only do so once proper communication has been made to safely stop the train.

5. The train will not exceed 10 barrels in total and must be operated by a small tractor with no attachments that weighs no less than 2000 lbs. and have at least a 20 hp. motor. It will operate on flat ground only in as straight a line as possible at a speed not to exceed 5 mph (a safe walking speed).
