

2023 CAMPING INFO

Camping is from 12:00 pm Sunday, July 30th - 12:00 pm Sunday, August 6th, 2023

<u>No campers, RV or motor homes will be allowed in the park before 12:00 pm</u> <u>on July 30th!</u>

Camping fee for the full week will be \$50 (Berthusen Park or west field). Whether you join us for one day or the entire week, the fee is \$50. All camping is dry camping; showers available on the show grounds. When paying, you will receive one camping pass and one vehicle pass for your RV or towing vehicle. All additional vehicles charged at \$10/per vehicle. All permits MUST BE DISPLAYED (in windows or on tent front) at all times while camping during our Vintage Farming Days show. You may camp in the park or in front of the caretaker's house, or the west field. There is a maximum of <u>1 vehicle per site</u> in the field in front of the caretaker's house and <u>2 vehicles per site</u> in the park or west field. If you're camped by the caretaker's house and you have a 2nd vehicle, we may ask you to park that vehicle in the west field & use the people mover. Camping is on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no reservations or saving of spots. We have never had to turn anyone away due to no vacancy. But this means that you park your rig responsibly & don't take up a lot of extra space so that we can accommodate everyone. When finding that perfect spot, there will be no moving of any logs in the park, they're there for a reason. Please respect the boundaries and the natural vegetation. NO TRACTORS/LAWNMOWERS ARE ALLOWED TO BE IN THE PARK FOR ANY REASON - they MUST stay in the show grounds area. Generators are allowed but guiet time is from 10:00 pm -6:00 a.m. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS DUE TO INSURANCE REASONS; if your dog is camping with you, they must be leashed at all times, not left unattended & you must pick up after them.

When you come on Sunday, **after 12:00 p.m. on July 30th**, please find a place to park your camping vehicle then see the camp host next to the caretaker's house to pay for your stay & get your camping & parking passes. The camp host must be able to see your camping/parking pass posted when they do their daily checks, so please keep them visible in the window of your RV/ trailer/vehicle or clipped to the outside front of your tent. Please abide by all rules, be respectful of others, keep your campsite tidy or you will be asked to leave.
